Abstracts should be submitted in English and should be sent **by September 30, 2013** using the EasyAbs System at <http://linguistlist.org/easyabs/LSI2013>.

Authors may submit no more than one individual or one joint (co-authored) proposal (**ONLY ONE ABSTRACT PER AUTHOR**). The abstracts should be anonymous, and fit on at most 2 pages including examples, tables/figures and references (using 12-point TIMES NEW ROMAN with reasonable margins).
