



Two Day Workshop on Computational Resources in Maithili

Linguistic Data Consortium for Indian Languages (LDC-IL), a scheme of the Government of India implemented by the Central Institute of Indian Languages, department of Higher Education, MHRD, Government of India, Mysore in collaboration with Darbhanga Public School is conducting a two day “Workshop on Computational Resources in Maithili”.

Registration:

Participant Eligibility:

Candidates must have a bachelors or Master’s Degree and must know Maithili, either as mother tongue or second language. Preference would be given to candidates having master’s degree. Knowledge of computers and typing is a must. Students/scholars studying Maithili language and literature are encouraged to apply.

Prizes

At the end of the workshop (last day), there will be a test on the topics covered in the workshop. Top three scorers in the test would be given a cash prize of Rs. 3,000/-, 2000/- and 1500/- respectively. Minimum score must be above 75% to be eligible for the prize. Certificate would also be issued to all the participants.

Short Term Job Opportunity

Participants who complete the workshop successfully and score a minimum of 60%, will also have the opportunity to visit CIIL, Mysore and work for a 45 to 90 day goal oriented workshop on development of different types of computational resources in Maithili. For the candidates going to Mysore for this long-term workshop, the travel expenses to and fro will be borne by CIIL as per GoI norms. Hostel accommodation will also be provided to such candidates during their stay at Mysore and along with an honorarium of Rs. 750/- per day.

Overview of Language Resources for NLP in Maithili: Text Data Preparation; Parts of Speech Annotation; Syntactic Parsing; Speech Data Preparation; Speech Data Annotation;
